	 It is to make sure you can join in when you need to say things
Why am I seeing you?	 See how you are getting on with communication (talking and listening)
	 See what might help you with communication in court
What will happen when I see you?	We will do some different talking and listening tasks.



How long will it take?	 It will take about one hour You can have breaks if you need to
	We will not talk about anything to do with why you need to go to court .
Support person	You can bring a support person with you.
Report	 I will write a report for the judge The report will be about your communication It will say what kinds of things will help you when you are talking or listening in court
Confidential	 The report I write is private It will only go to the people at court who need to know this information I will not give the report to anyone else I will not talk to anybody else about what you tell me
